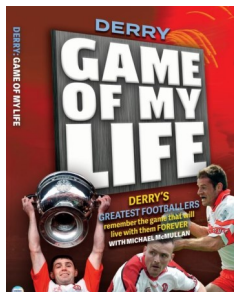
November Lists - Remembering our beloved deceased
